New Articulation Arrangement with London College of Communication (LCC) for Graduates of Postgraduate Diploma in Media and Cultural Critique

An articulation arrangement has been reached between HKU SPACE and London College of Communication (LCC), University of the Arts London (UAL) for graduates of Postgraduate Diploma in Media and Cultural Critique (PMCC) to further their studies to get a Master's degree.

PMCC graduates are now eligible to apply for the **MA Media, Communications and Critical Practice*** offered by the LCC at HKU SPACE, with an **exemption of 60 credits**, out of the total 180 credits. As one of the PMCC graduates, you will only be required to complete 3 units (120 credits) in the programme for the MA qualification.
