Programme Fee

1. **HK\$2,900** per each student.

Certificate of Attendance

Upon successful completion of the course, students will obtain the **Certificate of Attendance** from **ECNU**.

Application Process

1. Students who are interested to apply, please submit the **Application Form** to IC.
2. Students will also need to submit a short essay, in less than 100 words (English), describe your reasons for wanting to attend this programme, what you hope to achieve from it, and what makes you a good ambassador for IC.

Announcement of Result

1. Successful applicants will receive a notification email by IC within one week after the applicant deadline.
2. Applicants who do not receive the offer one week after the application deadline may consider their applications unsuccessful.

Pre-departure Orientation

Successful applicants will need to attend a pre-departure orientation where you will get to meet other students going with you and learn important information to help you prepare for the trip. Details will be announced by IC later.
