Dr Irene Tsang is Programme Director of Art and Design, College of Humanities and Law of HKU SPACE. She obtained her MA and PhD in art and archaeology from the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London. Before joining HKU SPACE, she had taught Chinese and Western art history in City University of Hong Kong and Hong Kong Polytechnic University. Her research interests include Chinese material culture, theatrical art, art and gender and collecting of Chinese ceramics. Her forthcoming book, *Visualizing Performance in Ancient China from Tomb Art*, is an attempt to encompass diverse fields of studies including archaeology, gender studies and art and cultural history in order to shed light on a unique set of attitudes about visual representation of performance in ancient Chinese tombs.
