Pascal de Sarthe started de Sarthe gallery in Paris in 1977 and moved the gallery to the United States in 1981. The gallery focuses on 19th and 20th century Asian and Western masters including artists such as Monet, Picasso, Warhol, Lin Fengmian, Zao Wou-Ki, Chu Teh Chun and T'ang Haywen. In 2010 Pascal de Sarthe moved to Hong Kong where he opened his gallery in Central with the inaugural exhibition of master works by Zao Wou-Ki created in the 1950s – 1960s. Recently de Sarthe Beijing was open by his son Vincent focusing on emerging Chinese contemporary artists.

Last year Pascal de Sarthe was listed in Art & Auction's "Power 100" list of the top 100 important people in the contemporary art world. He was also named as 2011's best art dealer in Asia by Chinese Contemporary Art News.
